
The Resilience Committee

- Our ideas are to help everyone in school be more resilient.


In Key Stage 5 we have a Resilient Quote of the Week which is displayed in the classrooms.


□ We have a Joke of the Week. This is to make sure that we start the week off in a fun way!






- We introduced 'Pupil of the Month'. Pupils get to vote for someone in their class who they feel has done really well.

- Each class has a winner.






□ We have designed and made 'shout out' cards.


Have delivered sessions to five out of the eight classes at Highfurlong, this is what our pupils say




